Saturday 1st June - Psalm 71 - Men's Groups

Please pray for the various men's groups from St Andrew's which meet this month - Men's Breakfast (today) and Word at the Wheatsheaf later in the month. Pray that men would feel welcome at our churches and that the men in these groups would be able to support each other in their life and witness.

Sunday 2nd June - Psalm 72 - Sunday Services

Pray for our worship this morning and this evening in our churches. Please remember particularly the 9:30am service at St Luke's. Pray that more would be drawn in from Willerby to worship our Lord Jesus.

Monday 3rd June - Psalm 73 – Schools' Work

Continue to pray for our schools work and all involved in leading it. Open the Book now takes place regularly in Carr Lane and St Andrew's Primary Schools, Fuse club (a lunchtime club) happens in St Andrew's and there is a Christian Union at Wolfreton School. Pray that the Bible will speak to the children of God's love for them and for his world. Thank him for these opportunities.

Tuesday 4th June - Psalm 74 - Mums and Tots/Toddler Group

Pray for the work of the weekly toddler groups at St Andrew's (Tuesdays) and St Luke's (Wednesdays). Pray for Anne and Alison who lead these groups and their teams that they may love of Jesus with the parents and grandparents who bring their toddlers along. Pray for opportunities to speak of Jesus for those from our church families.

Wednesday 5th June - Psalm 75 - Friendship Club

The Friendship Club meet at St. Luke's this afternoon at 2 pm. Many of those who attend live on their own and this social event provides at time of fellowship for them. Pray that the team may demonstrate God's love to all those who attend in the service they provide.

Thursday 6th June - Psalm 76 - Prayer

Please pray that prayer would be at the centre of all we do as churches. Pray for us to have a delight in time with our Heavenly Father and a passion to bring the world's needs before him. Pray for the weekly St Luke's gathering (tonight), the St Andrew's prayer evening and also for the weekly Friday Prayers@St Andrew's - that God would lead our prayers.

Friday 7th June - Psalm 77 - Youth Groups

Pray for our Friday night youth groups (Rockets and Impact). Please ask for fun and fellowship as well as good Bible teaching to inspire the young people with the Lord Jesus. Pray for the leaders as they prepare their talks. This term Impact is looking at the Psalms.

Saturday 8th June - Psalm 78 - St Luke's Summer Tea

This afternoon's Summer Tea at St Luke's welcomes many elderly people from our community for a light meal and entertainment. The event opens with a short gospel message. Please pray that this will speak a relevant word to all those attending.

Sunday 9th June - Psalm 79 - Pentecost

Thank God for his gift of his own Spirit to live permanently in the lives of Christians, first given on Pentecost. Pray for this work among us, directing our attention to the Lord Jesus, opening our hearts to hear God's call to us and mediating to us the love of God. Pray that he would move our hearts to respond to God's love, produce his fruit among us and empower us to serve Christ.

Monday 10th June - Psalm 80 - Leadership and PCCs

As St Luke's PCC meets tonight, pray for those who lead us in our churches. Pray that God might grant them wisdom as they lead us through the challenges we face. Pray that God might grant the PCC members discernment to lead us spiritually as well as practically.

Tuesday 11th June - Psalm 81 - Growth Groups

Pray for our Growth Groups as they meet tonight. Thank God for the opportunity to meet with God in small groups to learn and to grow in our faith together. Pray that these groups may be places where we can grow in faith, support each other and help each other face life's ups and downs with faith, hope and love.

Wednesday 12th June - Psalm 82 - Exams

Pray for our young people who are facing exams or waiting for exam results. Pray for God's peace for them and that they don't have regrets. Pray for those for whom these exams will be affecting the future direction of their lives.

Thursday 13th June - Psalm 83 - Mission Partners

Pray for the work of the St Andrew's Mission Partners. Today we remember David, Ruthie, Emily and Aiofe Lowry who are working in Senegal translating the Bible. We also remember the Moore family (David, Emma and Joshua) in their second year in Papua New Guinea supporting other missionaries through medical work and teaching.

Friday 14th June - Psalm 84 - Our Neighbours and Workplaces

Thank God for all who live near you – uphold your neighbours and colleagues along with others who we regularly meet, praying that opportunities may arise for them to encounter the Lord Jesus Christ.

Saturday 15th June - Psalm 85 - Women's Groups

Please pray for the various women's groups who meet at St Andrews' - Faith on Friday, Refresh and the Women's breakfasts (this morning). Thank God for these opportunities to meet together and to share God's Word together. Pray that these groups would be places of love, support and growth.

Sunday 16th June - Psalm 86 - Sunday Services

Today we gather again to worship God and to learn from his Word - thank God for this privilege and ask that his Spirit would be with us to make his love known and to transform us. Pray that we would grow in faith and love of Jesus this Sunday.

Monday 17th June - Psalm 87 - Family life

Pray for family life in our congregation. Pray that marriages would be protected by God and flourish in good times and bad. Pray for those whose marriages are going through rocky times. Pray for husbands and wives who we long for to come to share our faith in Jesus. Pray for those for whom parenting is hard at the moment. Pray for those who miss loved ones or who mourn never finding a partner.

Tuesday 18th June - Psalm 88 - Safeguarding

Protecting our children, young people and vulnerable adults is of key importance. Please pray for good safeguarding practice in our churches. Pray also wisdom and appropriate behaviour for all in our churches. Pray for Ash, Peter and Francis and others as they lead and administer our Safeguarding systems.

Wednesday 19th June - Psalm 89 - Raywell

Thank God for last year's 'Church weekend' at Raywell. Pray for Claire and the team as they meet this evening and throughout the summer to plan this September's Raywell weekend. Pray that this year's Raywell will be even better than last year's!

Thursday 20th June - Psalm 90 - Mission Partners

Pray for one of the partners supported by St Luke's - Leprosy Mission, MAF and the Gideons. Pray for God to be using them to make a difference both spiritually and physically to the people they serve. Why not check on the internet what their prayer needs are today?

Friday 21st June - Psalm 91 - Keswick Convention

Pray for the Keswick convention which starts in under a month. Thank God for the blessing that many from our churches have enjoyed through attending Keswick and learning from God there. Pray for the preparations for the convention, both on the ground in Keswick and in the hearts of those attending.

Saturday 22nd June - Psalm 92 - St Luke's Summer Fair

Pray for today's summer fair at St Luke's. Pray for all the practicalities and organisation. Pray that many would come in to join the church family and find something of the love of God as they join in with the fun.

Sunday 23rd June - Psalm 93 - Evening Service

Thank God for our freedom to worship him in the UK and for the opportunity for St Luke's and St Andrew's to worship together each Sunday evening. Pray that this service would be a helpful place for new people to our churches to worship God.

Monday 24th June - Psalm 94 - Finance

Tuesday 25th June - Psalm 95 - Books and Bookstall

Wednesday 26th June - Psalm 96 - Our Witness

Lord, we thank you that when we witness to your Son Jesus we are witnessing with you. Lead us into opportunities to speak of Jesus and give us the courage to speak and the words to say. Thank you that this is something we can all join in with. Amen.

Thursday 27th June - Psalm 97 - Mission Partners

Please remember the St Andrew's mission partners, Mike and Jo, serving God in Southeast Asia. Thank God for their work with those who are on the edge and in advising universities and the government. Pray for protection and fruitful work for God. Remember also the Myers family as they prepare to head out to Ethiopia as they make final arrangements.

Friday 28th June - Psalm 98 - Westfield House

Saturday 29th June - Psalm 99 - Thanksgiving
