Thursday 4th February Give thanks for the mission team at the Boulevard. Emma is preparing Christian packs for the families on love for Valentine's Day. Pray many would know the love of God in Jesus.

Saturday 6th February Pray that we would wait patiently for the end of lockdown, trusting in Jesus for all we need, not grumbling, but giving thanks to God for his many blessings.
