Wednesday 17th February Pray for families with children as they try to make half term look different from the rest of the year Pray for patience and forbearance in households.

Friday 19th February Pray for our government as they aim to publish a roadmap out of lockdown next week. Pray for wisdom and courage, especially for Christian MPs.

Sunday 21st February Today is Giving Sunday. Pray that we would all look to how we can best support gospel ministry in our churches in all ways, especially financially.

Sunday 28th February Give thanks that our churches are open. Pray that we would all be able to meet together and sing soon.

Monday 15th February Give thanks for our staff team – both those in Bible teaching roles and those in support roles. Pray they all grow in their love for Jesus.

Tuesday 16th February Give thanks for the work of Jonathan Hill and the team of volunteers at the St Martin's Food Bank which operates on Tuesdays. Pray for many gospel opportunities today.

Thursday 18th February Pray for St Andrew's Mission Partners, Mike and Jo in Myanmar as they contend with life and ministry after the military coup earlier this month.

Saturday 20th February Give thanks for new people joining our church family over the last few weeks. Pray that they would settle in well and get to know others despite the restrictions.

Monday 22nd February Pray for Christians in China where the Government is pressurising fellowships and individuals, especially via (facial recognition), a social credit score based on trustworthiness.

Wednesday 24th February Pray for those in the congregation who have recently had covid. Pray that the Lord would give them a speedy and full recovery.

Friday 26th February Pray for the children and young people in Rockets and Impact would understand the Gospel in such a way that they are all born again and growing in their love for the Lord Jesus.
