Prayer Diary – November 2022

Tuesday 1st November	We meet to pray tonight at the Prayer Evening . Pray that many people from both St Luke's and St Andrew's would join together in dependence on God. St Luke's Toddler Group and Little Stars leaders are gathering together this evening for a Faith in Kids Christmas training session. Pray that it would be useful and also a good time of fellowship.
Wednesday 2nd November	Give thanks for the Book of Common Prayer Communion Service at St Andrew's this morning, particularly for the way God is using this service for building up those who attend. Pray that God would continue to add to the number of those who gather.
Thursday 3rd November	Pray for our witness in our local schools, especially Carr Lane School as the Open the Book team lead assembly today.
Friday 4th November	Praise God for our children's and youth leaders who lead games and teach the Bible in LaunchPad, Rockets and Impact. Pray that God would raise up more leaders from within our church families.
Saturday 5th November	Bangers and Bonfire is this evening. Pray that it would be well attended, especially by Impacters and their friends.
Sunday 6th November	"Shout for joy to the LORD, all the earth. Worship the LORD with gladness; come before him with joyful songs" (Psalm 100:1-2). Pray that each of us would encounter the living God in worship today and find our joy in him.

Give thanks for Growth Groups that meet this week. Pray that each member would learn more of God's grace and sovereignty through Jonah.</p>
<p>Wednesday 9th November</p>	<p>Pray for the couples getting married at St Andrew's next year as they come to St Andrew's this evening to fill in their paperwork.</p>
<p>Thursday 10th November</p>	<p>Praise God for the gospel work at St John's Bransholme and praise him for the privilege St Andrew's has of partnering with them in prayer and financially.</p>
<p>Friday 11th November</p>	<p>Pray that the children and youth who attend LaunchPad, Rockets and Impact would all want to and be able to attend church on Sundays.</p>
<p>Saturday 12th November</p>	<p>Give thanks that the gospel was explained the Light Party and pray that the children who attended would come back to LaunchPad, Rockets or church.</p>
<p>Sunday 13th November</p>	<p>Today is Remembrance Sunday. Both our services will begin at 10am and end with an act of remembrance. Pray that we would all be thankful for Jesus, who gave his life as a sacrifice for his people.</p>
<p>Monday 14th November</p>	<p>Open the Book team is at St Andrew's School today and Carr Lane School on Thursday. Give thanks for the opportunity we have to take Bible stories into our local schools. Pray for St Luke's PCC meeting tonight, particularly for wisdom for the way forward in mission.</p>

Tuesday 15th November	Give thanks for everyone who is going to be involved in Christmas events and services. Pray that planning for Christmas runs smoothly and that very many in the church families would be involved in some way as we reach out to Willerby, Kirk Ella and beyond.
Wednesday 16th November	Praise God that you are loved by Jesus . Pray that he would enable you to live for Jesus more and more each day.
Thursday 17th November	Praise God for his beautiful creation, and thank him for the St Andrew's Flower Guild and the ladies who bring flowers into St Luke's.
Friday 18th November	Pray that LaunchPad, Rockets and Impact members would continue to invite and bring their schoolfriends to the groups.
Saturday 19th November	Give thanks for the ministry of the Anglican Mission in England , and particularly for the congregations in Hull, Christ Church Newland, Christ Church Riverside and Christ Church Orchard Park. Pray also for Lee McMunn as he settles into his new role as an Assistant Bishop.
Sunday 20th November	We come to God today in great need of his grace. Pray that God would use the Word, prayer, the sacrament and our heartfelt praise to build us up and equip us for his service in the week ahead.
Monday 21st November	St Andrew's is having urgent electrical works carried out today. Pray that it would go smoothly and benefit the church building for many years to come.
Tuesday 22nd November	Pray that the Little Stars team have plenty of opportunities to chat with parents and carers.
Wednesday 23rd November	Give thanks for all the families who have been to St Luke's Toddler Group over the years. Pray that those who come today would grow in their knowledge of God.
Thursday 24th November	Praise God that St Andrew's has had permission to change the kitchen into a dedicated Sunday Groups room and to create a coffee serving point at the back of the main church room. Praise God for the generous givers who have pledged

	money to pay for the work. Pray that we would give all the money that's needed, that a builder would be found, and the changes would be a blessing to the church family.
Friday 25th November	Pray that those leading in the various children's and youth groups would find spiritual refreshment for themselves each week.
Saturday 26th November	Diocesan Synod meets on Zoom today. Pray for Ash and John, as well as other evangelicals on it, that they would have opportunity to speak gospel truth and perhaps to influence decisions for the good.
Sunday 27th November	The words I have spoken to you are spirit and they are life" (John 6:63). Pray that as we hear God's Word today, we would encounter Jesus Christ and be renewed to rejoice in him and live for him in the week ahead.
Monday 28th November	As Christmas approaches, pray that those who find this time of year hard because of bereavement, loneliness or hard memories, would find comfort in the Lord Jesus Christ.
Tuesday 29th November	As we meet with non-Christian friends and family pray we would take every opportunity we have to share the hope of the gospel.
Wednesday 30th November	Give thanks for the food bank ministry at St Martin's . Pray that many people would stay for a cuppa and a chat, and that there would continue to be many opportunities to share the gospel with people and pray for them.
