Prayer Diary – January 2024

Monday 1st	Praise God for the very many people who came to both
	our churches and heard the good news of the gospel over
	the Christmas period. Pray that God would add to our
	number those who are being saved.
Tuesday 2 nd	Thank God for the new people who joined our churches in
	2023 (you might be one of them!) and ask him to add one
	family, couple or individual to each of St Andrew's and St
	Luke's each month during 2024.
Weds 3 rd	Praise God for the good relationships we have with our
	local schools – Carr Lane, Springhead, St Andrew's and
	Wold Academy – and pray that God would grant us
	continued access to help the children and staff know
	about Jesus in the year ahead.
Thursday 4 th	Give thanks for the life of John Davie whose funeral is at
	St Andrew's today. Pray for Jean, the rest of his family,
	and all who mourn a patient faith and deep trust in Jesus.
Friday 5 th	Thank God for his generosity towards us in every way,
	especially financially, and pray that he would provide for
	our needs in the year ahead through the sacrificial giving
	of the church families throughout the year ahead.
Saturday 6 th	Give thanks for all those who work behind the scenes
	cleaning our buildings and keeping them in good order.
	Pray that God would give them joy in their ministry.
Sunday 7 th	We meet today around God's Word. Pray that God would
	bring back some today who came over Christmas and
	that they might find their spiritual home at St Luke's or St
	Andrew's.

Monday 8 th	Most schools start back today or tomorrow. Pray that God
	would help the children of our churches to live
	distinctively for him this term, and that he would give
	them opportunities to share the good news of Jesus with
	their friends and courage to invite them to church or our
	Friday evening groups.
Tuesday 9 th	Pray for Little Stars that restarts today and St Luke's
	Toddler Group that restarts tomorrow. Ask that God
	would give all the leaders and helpers time to build
	meaningful, gospel centred relationships with the families
	who come.
	We meet to pray tonight at the Benefice Prayer Evening,
	7:45 for 8pm at the Memorial Hall. Pray many come.
Weds 10 th	Pray for the Open the Book team in Carr Lane School this
	morning, that God would give them clarity and confidence
	as they lead the assembly, and also that the children listen
	well today and all term.
Thursday 11 th	Today the Staff Team have their Christmas Recovery
	Lunch . Pray that God would grant them a slightly quieter
	month and that they'd all be able to pace themselves well
	this coming year.
Friday 12 th	LaunchPad, Rockets and Impact all restart this afternoon
	and evening. Pray that God would bring back everyone,
	and that some who found out about these groups over
	Christmas would join, hear the gospel, and be saved.
Saturday 13 th	Pray that the Church of England would be united around
	the gospel and that Bishops and Archbishops would drive
	out error as they promised to do at their concecrations.
Sunday 14 th	We meet around God's Word today. This morning we
	restart our series in Galatians. Pray that God would be
	teaching us more deeply what it looks like to trust in
	Jesus alone for all we need.
Monday 15 th	Pray for wisdom and courage to follow Jesus in everything
	for St Andrew's PCC as they meet tonight.

Tuesday 16th	Praise God for Growth Groups , and ask that they would
_	all be unflinchingly Jesus centred each time they meet
	this term, starting tonight, tomorrow and Thursday.
Weds 17 th	Give thanks for the ministry the midweek communion
	service has which is at St Andrew's at 10:30am this
	morning, and pray for perseverance to keep following
	Jesus for those who attend.
Thursday 18th	Pray for St Andrew's Flower Guild and those who make St
	Luke's look pretty, that they'd always see their work as
	part of their life of worship and service of God.
Friday 19 th	Cry out to God for the children and youth of our parishes,
	that many would turn to the Light of Christ in this dark
	world. Pray that many come to our Friday groups today.
Saturday 20 th	Pray for our Mission Partners, the Myers Family , that God
	would give them wisdom to decide their best next move.
Sunday 21st	As we share the Lord's Supper this morning, pray that God
	would use it to keep us trusting in only the death of Jesus
	for our rescue from sin and judgment.
Monday 22 nd	Pray for wisdom and courage to follow Jesus in everything
	for St Luke's PCC as they meet tonight.
Tuesday 23 rd	Pray that Little Start and St Luke's Toddler Group would
	reach whole families with the good news of the gospel.
Weds 24 th	Praise God that the gospel is for people from every
	nation. Give him great thanks that increasingly our
	churches are reflecting the ethnic and cultural diversity of
	God's Kingdom.
Thursday 25 th	Give thanks for how the Women's Christian Book Club
	that meets this evening at St Luke's has helped many
	women grow in their faith through reading good Christian
	books and discussing them together.
Friday 26 th	Give thanks for the ministry among older people, at the
	Men's Coffee Morning Jolly, Faith on Friday, and
	Friendship Club. Pray for good conversations about Jesus
	at Friendship Club this afternoon.

Saturday 27 th	Give much thanks to God for the completion of the
	children's room at St Andrew's. Pray that over the coming
	weeks, months and years many children would give their
	lives to Jesus because of what they learn there. And give
	thanks for the new families at St Luke's and pray that the
	church would be able to provide a fledgling Sunday School
	for the children.
Sunday 28 th	Pray that God would bring visitors and enquirers to all of
	our services today.
Monday 29 th	Pray for Vicky Earle (Derringham) and Kevin Barnard
	(Swanland) who have recently been appointed as vicars in
	our neighbouring parishes. Pray that the evangelical clergy
	in the area would be a great encouragement to them as
	they seek to hold out the gospel in new settings.
Tuesday 30 th	Pray that those who are ill in our parishes would hold
	firmly to the hope of the gospel and the promise of the
	new creation where there will be no sickness or death.
Weds 31st	Look back over the month and give thanks to God for one
	thing in your personal walk with the Lord, and one thing
	that God has done in our churches.
