## Harvest Festival – Sunday 6th October

We are also collecting other non-perishables such as tinned vegetables, pasta, rice, cereals, tea, coffee and squash for St Martin's Community Hub who provide food packages for people in need of emergency help.

Following the service at 12.30pm on 6<sup>th</sup> October we will be having a lunch at the Memorial Hall. It will be a bring your own food lunch followed by a time of thanksgiving prayer for our mission partners to include some short videos from the mission partners.
